FAQs



- **Q:** Can a student submit more than one video?
- A: YES! Students can submit more than one video and be on more than one team.
- Is there a limit to the number of videos any one student or school can submit?
- A: NO! Students and schools can submit as many videos as they'd like.
- **Q:** Can someone appear in a video that's NOT in grades 7-12?
- A: YES! However, they cannot be listed as a member of your team and cannot be awarded any prizes.
- Can extras appear in videos even if they are not part of the 6 person team?
- A: YES! However, they cannot be listed as a member of your team and cannot be awarded any prizes.
- **O:** Can an entry be a TikTok video?
- A: YES! As long as it is still submitted as a YouTube link.

THINGS THAT WILL HELP MY VIDEO STAND OUT

- Have a clear message
- Follow the video theme by using at least one of the provided topics
- Make sure you have good sound quality
- Stay within the 30-60 second time frame
- Be creative and think outside the box
- Keep facts short and simple
- Use credible sources for facts
- Avoid dead space or long pauses
- Include a tag for Project Prevent at the end



THINGS THAT WILL GET MY VIDEO DISQUALIFIED

- Using real tobacco products or packaging
- Videos shorter than 30 seconds
- Videos longer than 60 seconds
- Videos showing violence or illicit activity
- Not including a tag for Project Prevent at the end
