

# DRAWING FOR A DIFFERENCE

## 2022 RULES AND PRIZES

This year's theme is **Changing Gears!** You may choose from one of two options for your artwork:

- Change the way young people think about tobacco and nicotine products and help them understand the benefits of living tobacco- and nicotine-free.
- Change how parents and teachers react to youth nicotine use by offering support for quitting rather than punishment.

## PROJECT GUIDELINES

Open to Arkansas students in grades K-3. Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third-place winners for each grade. The artwork should focus on the supplied theme topics. All artwork must be created by the students. The artwork should be on plain white paper, size 8.5 x 11 inches. Students may use pencil, ink, crayons, markers or paint. Entries that are graphic or violent in nature will not be eligible.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

A third party will judge all artwork and the winners will be announced in May 2022. Judging will be based on the following criteria:

- Creativity
- Effectiveness/Accuracy of Message
- Ethics/Good Taste
- Quality of Art
