project guidelines

Open to Arkansas students in grades K-3. Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third-place winners for each grade. The artwork should focus on the supplied theme topic. All artwork must be created by the students. The artwork should be on plain white paper, size 8.5 x 11 inches. Students may use pencil, ink, crayons, markers or paint. Entries that are graphic or violent in nature will not be eligible.

selection criteria

A third party will judge all artwork and the winners will be announced in May 2023. Judging will be based on the following criteria:

- Creativity
- Effectiveness/Accuracy of Message
- Ethics/Good Taste
- Quality of Art

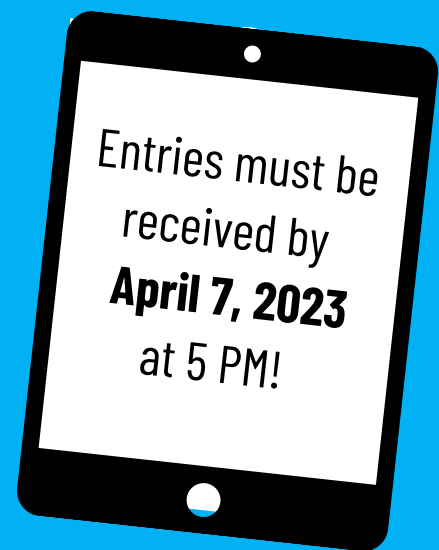

project guidelines

Open to Arkansas students in grades 4-6. Prizes will be awarded to first, second and third-place winners for each grade. The essays should focus on the supplied theme topics. All essays must be written by the students. Essays should be no more than 500 words for grades 4-5 and no more than 750 words for grade 6. Entries that are graphic or violent in nature will not be eligible.

selection criteria

A third party will judge all essays and the winners will be announced in May 2023. Judging will be based on the following criteria:

- Creativity
- Effectiveness/Accuracy of Message
- Ethics/Good Taste
- Quality of Writing

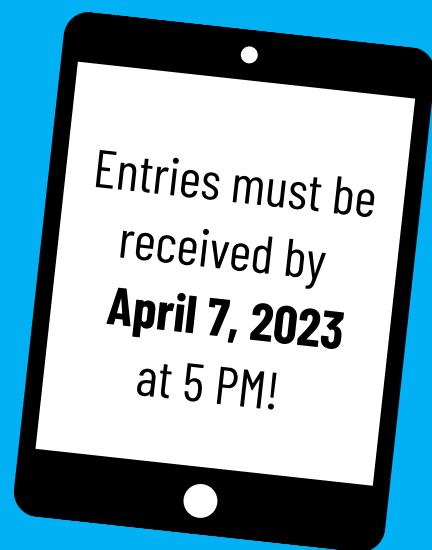
